2 The unaudited standalone financial results for the quarter and nine months ended 31 December 2025 ('the results') of the Nurture Well Industries Limited ('the Company') (formerly Integrated Industries Limited) have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of Companies Act, 2013 ('The Act') read with the relevant rules thereunder and in terms of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India ('SEBI') (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.

3 The Standalone results of the Company for the quarter and nine months ended 31 December 2025 have been reviewed by Statutory Auditor and they have issued an unmodified audit report on the same. The audit report of the statutory auditors is being filed with ('BSE') and is also available on the Company's website

4 In the context of reporting business / geographical segment as required by Ind AS 108 - "Operating Segments", the Company's operations comprise of mainly one business segment - Trading of Goods. Hence, there is no reportable segment as per Ind AS 108. However, the company's industry has been reclassified from "Packaged foods Industries" to "Holding company" w.e.f. 8th July 2025 based on the intimation received from BSE vide their email dated 8th July 2025.

5 The name of the company has been changed from Integrated Industries Limited to "Nurture Well Industries Limited" vide MCA order dated 27th January, 2026 and accordingly, the company has applied for change in name to Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) and approval of the same is pending.

- The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on February 12, 2026. The Auditors have carried out a Limited Review of these Results.
- The Company has executed an Agreement for Sale on July 23, 2025 for the sale of land parcels admeasuring approx. 17.77 acres together with 50% undivided right, title and interest in the access road admeasuring approx. 2.73 acres and for grant of perpetual non-exclusive right of way over a land parcel admeasuring 0.16 acre or thereabouts situated at Kalwe and Dighe, in Thane District for a consideration of approx. Rs.673 Crore and has received an advance of Rs.110 Crore from the purchaser. This transaction is subject to necessary approvals/ permission/ NOCs from Government and various concerned authorities and fulfillment of conditions precedent. The said asset has been shown as 'Assets Held for Sale' in accordance with Ind AS-105.
- The Government of India has implemented four new labour codes ("Codes") including the codes on Wages, 2019, w.e.f. 21st November 2025. The company has given effect of Gratuity and Leave Encashment considering uniform definition of "wages" as per the Codes on Wages in standalone financial results and consolidated financial results for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December 2025. The Company continues to monitor the finalization of Central / State Rules and clarifications from the Government on other aspects of the Labour Code and would provide appropriate accounting effects on the basis of such developments as and when needed.
- The Board of Directors of the Company in its meeting held on May 16, 2025 approved sale and transfer of part of Industrial Machinery Division namely designing, manufacturing, Erection and Commissioning of EOT Cranes, other material handling and process plant equipment activities of the Company ("Business") on a going concern basis by way of slump sale to Mukand Heavy Engineering Limited ("MHLE"), a wholly owned subsidiary of the company, through execution of Business Transfer Agreement ("BTA"). The BTA is executed on October 18, 2025. The slump sale is expected to be completed in near future, subject to terms and conditions prescribed under the BTA. The purchase consideration shall be discharged by MHLE by issuance of requisite number of equity shares of MHLE on the closing date. The said assets / liabilities have been shown as 'Assets / Liabilities held for sale' in accordance with Ind AS-105.

As per the applicable Ind AS, the Business has been classified as Discontinuing Operations for all the periods presented in these unaudited standalone financial results of the Company. Since the transaction is with a wholly owned subsidiary Company, there is no impact on the unaudited consolidated financial results.

# Beyond authority is lame excuse: HC wrath for BMC

In Powai road encroachment case, AMC in court; BMC to remove mobile toilets in 48 hrs; civic chief to give plan in 10 days to remove encroachments

Calling the BMC's stand a "lame excuse" and a "complete abdication of its powers", the Bombay High Court (HC) on Friday remarked that the civic body is failing to act against encroachments on a busy road in suburban Powai.

A bench of Justices Ravindra Ghuge and Abhay Mantri said the corporation was statutorily bound to discharge its duties and could not adopt a position that effectively appeased encroachers.

The court continued the hearing in a petition filed by Beaumont HFSI School and its principal, Kalyani Patnaik, alleging that despite repeated complaints, the BMC failed to remove slum dwellers occupying a road near the institute. The petitioners claimed the civic body instead facilitated the encroachments by providing toilets and water.

The court, on Thursday, had

directed the BMC to file an affidavit submitting a plan for removal of the encroachments. It had also directed the assistant municipal commissioner (AMC) of the ward concerned to remain present in the court for hearing on Friday.

Accordingly, the AMC was present and an affidavit was

filed, wherein it only stated that it would remove the mobile toilets within 48 hours. There was "not a whisper" or a plan on removal of the encroachers. In its affidavit, the BMC maintained that the stretch was a private road owned by a developer and therefore beyond its enforcement authority.

Rejecting the justification, the bench said the explanation reflected that the BMC lacked the "will, desire, courage or means" to deal with the problem.

The judges noted that the road was extensively being used for public and vehicular passage. It questioned such a "private road" used extensively could escape civic responsibility merely because of ownership.

Senior advocate Naushad Engineer, appearing for the petitioners, argued that statutory provisions required the corporation to ensure smooth traffic on all streets used by

citizens, including private roads.

He submitted that the builder built the road and handed it over to the BMC. He reasoned that even if it were a private road, and citizens complained about encroachment to the BMC, the builder does not have any authority to remove the same.

In its detailed order, the court noted that after the "marathon" hearing on Thursday, it had asked the BMC to give a plan for removal of encroachment, which the civic body failed to comply with.

The court directed the municipal commissioner to submit within 10 days a concrete plan to remove the encroachments, cautioning that it should not be an "eye-wash". It also ordered the removal of mobile toilet units from the road within 48 hours and warned that continued inaction could invite contempt proceedings.

# NGO flags 9 restaurants with service charges, urges action

Mumbai Grahak Panchayat writes to CCPA; seeks records for three years for amount collected so far

The Mumbai Grahak Panchayat (MGP) has written to the chairperson of the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) regarding alleged violations of the CCPA's directives prohibiting restaurants and hotels from levying mandatory service charges on consumers.

The FPJ contacted all the restaurants tabled in the letter for their alleged violations, but none of them responded.

In the letter, MGP chairman Advocate Shirish Deshpande referred to the Delhi High Court judgment dated March 28, 2025, which categorically upheld the validity of the CCPA directives and dismissed writ petitions filed by hotel and restaurant associations. "The court's ruling has reinforced the principle that consumers cannot be compelled to pay service charges against their wishes," the letter stated.

The MGP said that despite clear legal position, its vigilance efforts revealed that several restaurants continue to compulsorily charge and recover service charges, either directly or under different nomenclatures such as "charity contribution, staff welfare or staff contribution".

In some cases, the menu cards allegedly carry fine-print notes stating, "A voluntary 10% tip for the service staff has been proposed to be added to your bill. If you would like it removed, please let your server know." In other instances, the note reads: "We provide for a discretionary staff contribution for the benefit of the kitchen and service staff working at the restaurant. This will be removed if you do not opt for it."

The MGP has identified nine restaurants that allegedly levied additional charges. These include Mumbai establishments such as Pizza by the Bay, which reportedly added a

10% tip under the name of "charity commission", along with the note offering removal on request.

Sizzler's - The Food Studio allegedly charged a 5% tip with a note stating that an additional service charge is levied. Only Parathas, TAT, and Kamat's Legacy were also named for charging extra amounts as service charges. Banana Leaf and Punjab Grill allegedly charged 5% and 10%, respectively, under the labels "staff welfare" and "staff contribution".

The MGP has also sought an investigation into their records for the last three financial years to determine the total amount collected under the head "service charge" or any other similar nomenclature, and to direct that the entire amount, along with penal interest, be credited to the Central Consumer Welfare Fund. Additionally, the MGP has requested the CCPA to issue a fresh public advisory.

### Man booked for stalking woman

**MUMBAI:** The Amboli police have booked a man for allegedly stalking a 22-year-old woman outside her office on Veera Desai Road, Andheri West. According to the FIR, Nandkumar Jadhav alias Vijay Jadhav sat outside her workplace for 15 days, approached her for her name and number, stared at her and later sent social media requests. Eventually, the woman filed a complaint on February 12.

### Woman crushed under dumper

**MUMBAI:** A 51-year-old woman was killed after being hit by a speeding dumper truck in Powai on Thursday. The deceased, Bhagyawanti Devbanshi, a resident of Powai, was crossing Chandivali Farm Road near Buddha Vihar at 8.45pm when the vehicle struck her. She was trapped under the rear wheel and died of severe head injuries. The incident was witnessed by her 22-year-old daughter. The driver has been arrested for rash and negligent driving.

### Kid hurt in chain snatching case

**MUMBAI:** An eight-year-old girl was injured after an unidentified man allegedly snatched her gold locket chain in Kandivali East on February 12. According to the FIR, Mahak Pawar, a Class 2 student, was walking to school with friends when the man asked if he should remove her chain. When she refused, he cut it with a blade, injuring her right thumb. The Kurar police have registered an FIR.



## Safety first

Days after a Class 12 student fell off a moving train while going to his exam centre in Kalwa, the Railway Police have undertaken a public awareness campaign. Students were guided about safe travel during morning and evening rush hours at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus. -Vijay Gohil

# Dharavi's renewal is triggering city-wide change

Mumbai is likely to see several quiet yet lasting benefits from the Dharavi Redevelopment Project. Without this large-scale renewal effort, many of these changes would probably not have taken shape through the city's usual planning process.

Several urban features that had remained stalled or simply absent from Mumbai's development roadmap are now being unlocked because of the sheer scale of this redevelopment. Rehabilitating nearly 10 lakh people within Dharavi and across multiple land parcels within the Mumbai Metropolitan Region requires solutions that go well beyond housing. In the process, the city itself begins to develop and change.

At its core, the Dharavi Redevelopment Project (DRP)



is one of India's most ambitious urban renewal efforts, aimed at providing dignified, home-for-home rehabilitation to residents who have lived for decades in overcrowded and unsafe conditions. But as work gathers momentum, the project is increasingly being viewed as something larger. It is becoming a city-shaping intervention with ripple effects across Mumbai.

Dharavi's central location makes this impact unavoidable. Decisions taken here influence transport, land use, infrastructure, and environmental planning well beyond its boundaries. As a result, development is being trig-

gered in areas that had long remained stuck in planning limbo.

One visible outcome is the activation of land parcels in Kurla, Kanjurmarg, Bhandup, Mulund, and Malad. These sites, previously constrained by planning and logistical challenges, are now entering the development framework.

Mobility is another major gain. Dharavi is being reimaged as a multi-modal transport hub, integrating rail, Metro corridors, and arterial roads. This not only shortens daily commutes but also strengthens Mumbai's long-term public transport network.

Environmental recovery forms another critical layer. The long-polluted Mithi River is set to undergo rejuvenation, with plans for flood mitigation, cleaner channels, and accessible public spaces along its banks like in other cities globally.

The project is also accelerating solutions for the Deonar dumping ground, which is Mumbai's, and, arguably India's, largest landfill. Scientific waste processing and bio-mining are expected to reduce legacy waste, reclaim land, and lower health risks for surrounding neighbourhoods.

A broader eligibility framework includes even upper-floor residents who are normally excluded in other slum schemes. Crucially, the plan recognises Dharavi as an economic engine. Proposed livelihood hubs aim to strengthen industries with a declared tax holiday for five years.

- The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on February 12, 2026. The Auditors have carried out a Limited Review of these Results.
- The Company has executed an Agreement for Sale on July 23, 2025 for the sale of land parcels admeasuring approx. 17.77 acres together with 50% undivided right, title and interest in the access road admeasuring approx. 2.73 acres and for grant of perpetual non-exclusive right of way over a land parcel admeasuring 0.16 acre or thereabouts situated at Kalwe and Dighe, in Thane District for a consideration of approx. Rs.673 Crore and has received an advance of Rs.110 Crore from the purchaser. This transaction is subject to necessary approvals/ permission/ NOCs from Government and various concerned authorities and fulfillment of conditions precedent. The said asset has been shown as 'Assets Held for Sale' in accordance with Ind AS-105.
- The Government of India has implemented four new labour codes ("Codes") including the codes on Wages, 2019, w.e.f. 21st November 2025. The company has given effect of Gratuity and Leave Encashment considering uniform definition of "wages" as per the Codes on Wages in standalone financial results and consolidated financial results for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December 2025. The Company continues to monitor the finalization of Central / State Rules and clarifications from the Government on other aspects of the Labour Code and would provide appropriate accounting effects on the basis of such developments as and when needed.
- The Board of Directors of the Company in its meeting held on May 16, 2025 approved sale and transfer of part of Industrial Machinery Division namely designing, manufacturing, Erection and Commissioning of EOT Cranes, other material handling and process plant equipment activities of the Company ("Business") on a going concern basis by way of slump sale to Mukand Heavy Engineering Limited ("MHLE"), a wholly owned subsidiary of the company, through execution of Business Transfer Agreement ("BTA"). The BTA is executed on October 18, 2025. The slump sale is expected to be completed in near future, subject to terms and conditions prescribed under the BTA. The purchase consideration shall be discharged by MHLE by issuance of requisite number of equity shares of MHLE on the closing date. The said assets / liabilities have been shown as 'Assets / Liabilities held for sale' in accordance with Ind AS-105.

As per the applicable Ind AS, the Business has been classified as Discontinuing Operations for all the periods presented in these unaudited standalone financial results of the Company. Since the transaction is with a wholly owned subsidiary Company, there is no impact on the unaudited consolidated financial results.

## हजार कोटीची जमीन पुन्हा सरकारी ताब्यात!

मालाड मालवणी भागात मोठ्या प्रमाणात बांगलादेशी आणि रोहिंग्याची घुसखोरी असल्याच्या तक्रारी स्थानिक नागरिकांनी केल्या होत्या. यावर तातडीने कारवाई करण्याचे आदेश मंत्री लोढा यांनी दिले होते. गेल्या वर्षभरात सातत्याने त्यांनी या कारवाईचा पाठपुरावा केला असून अनधिकृत बांधकामावर कारवाई अद्यापही सुरुच आहे. आतापर्यंत गेल्या वर्षभरात केवळ पश्चिम उपनगरात १५ एकर जमिनीवरील अनधिकृत बांधकामावर हातोडा पडला असून या जमिनी पुन्हा सरकारी ताब्यात आल्या आहेत. एक हजार कोटीपेक्षा जास्त या जमिनीची किमती असल्याची माहिती पश्चिम उपनगर (अतिक्रमण निष्कासन) अतिरिक्त आयुक्त गणेश मिसाल यांनी ही माहिती दिली. धडक मोहीम अद्यापही सुरुच असल्याचे मिसाल म्हणाले.

अमली पदार्थ माफियांचा मुद्दा उचलून धरला होता. मुंबई उपनगर जिल्हा नियोजन बैठकीतही प्रामुख्याने हा मुद्दा चर्चिला गेला. मुंबईला बसत असलेला घुसखोरांचा विळखा आणि धोक्यात येत असलेली मुंबईची सुरक्षितता यावर चर्चा झाल्यानंतर जिल्हा नियोजन बैठकीतच मंत्री
